**BOROUGH OF WOKING (COLDHARBOUR ROAD)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2018**

Woking Borough Council in exercise of its powers under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police hereby makes the following Order:-

1. In this Order "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and includes a motor cycle.
2. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed or ride or cause to be ridden any pedal bicycle or tricycle on, Saturday 14th July 2018 between 12:15 and 13:00 hours in that length of Coldharbour Road, Pyrford, Woking, between its junction with Dane Court and its junction with Engliff Lane in the Borough of Woking.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in that Article, if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (b) For fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (c) In the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 14th day of July 2018, and may be cited as the Borough of Woking (Coldharbour Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2018.
